Good Morning! We're glad you're here today worshipping with us and hope that you'll come again real soon. If you are a first-time visitor, we invite you to pick up a special coffee mug in the narthex after the service. Information about our programs, mission projects, and group opportunities is included in a brochure inside the mug. The following information may also be helpful for you...

The Lord's Supper is observed weekly at First Christian. This is Christ's table, and all believers in him are invited to partake. Please eat the bread as it is passed to you, but hold the cup until all have been served. After reciting John 3:16 in unison, we will then drink the cup together.

The Hymn of Commitment provides an opportunity for those who have never done so to come forward and make a public confession of faith in Jesus Christ. A service of baptism sometime in the future would then follow. Those wishing to transfer their membership from another congregation to First Christian are also invited to come forward at this time and unite with us by a simple restatement of faith.

Worship Pads for registering your attendance are passed during the early part of the service. Please take note of those worshipping with you and be sure to take time to welcome them to our worship. Visitors are asked to leave their address.

Offering envelopes in the pew holders may be used for general budget offerings as well as offerings for the capital campaign and special offerings.

First Christian Church celebrated a century of service in Stillwater in December of 1997. We are affiliated with the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), the oldest Christian Denomination with origin on American Soil.
